2. Tournament venue and date

Date of the tournament: September 27, 2024 to September 29, 2024

3. Liability

The organizers mentioned under point 1 and their employees are not responsible before, during and after the tournament and are not liable for any theft, damage, accidents and injuries, regardless of the function of the person concerned, e.g. employees, coaches, athletes, referees, etc. All hotel bookings are made at the participant's own risk. Club managers, team managers and coaches ensure that all their participants are physically fit and adequately prepared for participation in the registered competitions. Furthermore, this is also the responsibility of each individual athlete. All tournament participants, regardless of their ability, are recommended to take out appropriate personal health and accident insurance (liability).

4. Rules and organization of the tournament

The following rules apply to the current tournament:

- **JJIF Competition Rules (latest version)**
- **Organization and Sport Code of the JJIF Version SC 1.0**
- All participants are asked to respect fair play and the JJIF Code of Ethics.
- The Code of Conduct for Trainers, as defined in the JJIF Organizational Rules, is strictly observed, including the Dress Code (see OSC).

There will be 4 competition areas. The competition areas will be 12m x 12m, of which 8m x 8m will be the fighting area. A video review system will be used on each competition area. The rules of the JJIF-Challenge apply.

5. Ranking of the participants (seeding) and draw

In this tournament there is no fixed ranking of the participants before the draw. Athletes will be weighed the day before their bouts and the draws for the next day will be published the evening after the weigh-in. This will be announced via the [social media channels](#) of the German Ju-Jutsu Federation. The draws can be viewed under [Sportdata](#) after publication. There is a 2-hour objection period, which starts after publication of the draws, for errors in the draws.

6. Participation rights and competition categories

The Ju-Jutsu Fighting, Duo and Jiu-Jitsu disciplines will be contested according to the normal JJIF competition categories for both genders in the U14, U16 and U18 age groups. A double start in different disciplines is possible. The participating athletes should have a certain amount of experience, this is for their own protection and that of the other athletes.

Eligible to start are:

- **U14:** Athletes born between January 1, 2011 and December 31, 2012.
- **U16:** Athletes born between January 1, 2009 and December 31, 2010.
- **U18:** Athletes born between January 1, 2007 and December 31, 2008.

No paid athletes within the meaning of § 67a of the Tax Code are permitted to compete.

7. Registration and participation fee

Registration is possible until **September 13, 2024** via Sportdata or SportsID. The participation fee is **60€** per starter (Fighting, BJJ, Duo couple). For registrations after **September 13, 2024** an additional fee of **10€** will be charged.

8. Merging of competition categories

After the weigh-in, competition categories with fewer than three participants will be merged if possible. The rules of the [JJIF sporting code](#) apply. If this is not feasible, the competition categories with fewer than three participants will be fought out. Competition categories with only one participant will receive their entry fee back.

9. Referee

Judges who wish to take part in the tournament should register directly with the Assistant to the President, Barbara Benz, by e-mail. The contact details are:

The DJJV will pay for the travel and accommodation of the invited judges as well as a daily allowance. Referees require a valid referee license.

10. Trainers, physiotherapists and medical staff

Athletes may participate without a coach. Medical staff from the German Ju-Jutsu Association will be on site to provide any necessary treatment. Athletes may bring their own physiotherapists and medical staff.

11. Visa

Each participant who requires a visa must apply for it independently. It is recommended to apply for the visa in good time to avoid delays. If documents are required, the German Ju-Jutsu Association must be contacted with a corresponding request.

12. Hotels and transportation

Each participant is responsible for finding their own accommodation. Participants are also responsible for their own transportation to the weigh-in and competition.

13. Timetable for registration, weighing and competitions

- Weighing: 18:00 - 20:00

Saturday, September 28, 2024:

- Start of competition: 9:00
- U14 & U16 Fighting, U18 BJJ, U18 Duo
- Weighing: 16:00 - 17:30

Sunday, September 29, 2024:

- Start of the competition: 9:00
- U18 Fighting, U14 & U16 BJJ, U14 & U16 Duo

14. Online transmission and data protection

By participating in the tournament, participants agree that they can be shown in the live broadcasts. Should this be a problem, please contact the organizer in advance. All personal data will be processed and protected in accordance with the data protection regulations of the German Ju-Jutsu Association.
